**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This paper provides a review of the budget which was approved by the Steering Committee of the African Flight Procedure Programme (AFPP) during its 6<sup>th</sup> meeting on 3 September 2020 (SC/6) and the corresponding expenditures and contributions. It also provides an overview of the payment status of the payment requests which were issued since SC/6.

**1. INTRODUCTION**

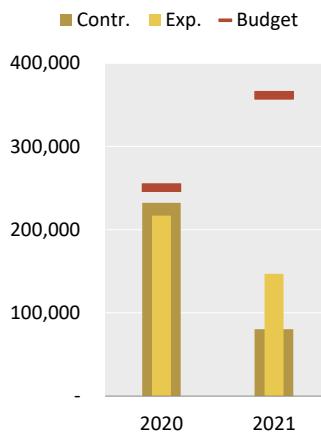
1.1 During its 6<sup>th</sup> meeting, the steering committee of the AFPP reviewed and approved a revised budget for the period until the scheduled end date of Phase II on 7 February 2022.

1.2 The present paper provides a review of this approved budget and the corresponding expenditures, outstanding commitments and received contributions for the period from 1 January 2020 to 30 September 2021.

## 2. DISCUSSION

### 2.1 Approved budget (SC/6) vs. actual expenditures and contributions

#### *Overview at project level*



2.1.1 The figure above shows a comparison of the approved budget for 2020 and 2021 (in United States dollars) with the corresponding expenditures (including outstanding commitments) and received contributions as at 30 September 2021<sup>1</sup>. The main observations are the following:

- a) In 2020, the expenditures amount to about 90 per cent of the approved budget. The gap is due to the date of the Steering Committee meeting in September that year, when most of the expenditures had already been made.
- b) In 2021, the expenditures as at 30 September are about 60 per cent below the approved budget. The expenditures exceed the received contributions by about US\$ 65,000.

2.1.2 The table above shows a review of the approved budget for 2020 and 2021 (in United States dollars) with the corresponding expenditures and received contributions as at 30 September 2021. The main observations are the following:

- a) Expenditures are overall close to the budget for 2020 due to the date at which the budget was calculated.
- b) For 2021, the expenditures as at 30 September should correspond to 75 per cent of the budget. The actual expenditures however are substantially less. The overestimations are due to:
  - 1) A buffer in the budget for the AFPP Manager and the recruitment of local support staff which was not carried out;
  - 2) Significantly less travel than estimated due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
  - 3) Reduced overhead cost (which is included in ‘Miscellaneous’) as a result of the savings described above.

## 2.2 Current fund balance

2.2.1 As shown in the table above, the expenditures during 2020 and the first 9 months of 2021 exceed the received contributions by approximately US\$ 50,000. Given the project balance of about US\$ 215,000 on 1 January 2020, the balance as at 30 September 2020 is close to US\$ 165,000.

## 2.3 Status of payment requests

2.3.1 Between January 2020 and September 2021, a total of 30 payment requests for a total amount of US\$ 978,884 were issued. These payment requests covered:

- a) Outstanding payments from the period prior to January 2020;
- b) Annual contributions for the period from January 2020 onwards; and
- c) The payment of services delivered by the AFPP, such as assistance with the design of flight procedures or the delivery of training and workshops.

2.3.2 Out of these 30 payment requests, 15 were settled (at least in part), and contributions of about US\$ 310,000 were received.

#### **2.4 Additional information**

2.4.1 The summary of outstanding membership fees by Active Member is provided in Appendix 1.

2.4.2 The budget which was approved during the meeting SC/6 is provided in Appendix 2.

2.4.3 The financial statements for the expenditures during 2020 and from January to September 2021 are provided in Appendices 3 and 4.

2.4.4 The payment requests sent and contributions received during this period are provided in Appendix 5.

### **3. CONCLUSION**

3.1 The project budget which was approved during SC/6 was not fully implemented. The differences between the budget and the actuals and forecast are mainly due to the delayed recruitment of local support staff and the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, due to which mission travel, training activities and on-site assistance were mostly done virtually. Although the expenses since SC/6 exceed the received contributions by about US\$ 50,000, a balance of close to US\$ 165,000 is available as at 30 September 2021.

3.2 The Steering Committee meeting is invited to take note of the information presented in this paper.
