3. Language

3.1. The workshop will be conducted in English language.

4. Opening Session

4.1. The opening session of the workshop will take place on Tuesday 19 November 2024 at 09:00 hours, UTC.

5. Working hours

5.1. The expected working hours of the workshop will be from 08:30 to 16:00 hours UTC.

6. Documentation

6.1. The workshop will be paperless, and all related documentation will be made available online. Therefore, participants are informed to bring laptop computers for access to workshop documentation.

7. Weather

7.1. The average temperature in Dakar is 28° in November. The local time in Senegal is UTC.

8. Entry visas

8.1. Senegalese visas are obtainable at Senegal Embassies or consulates in their country. Participants from States without Senegalese foreign missions are required to send a copy of their passports at least one month prior to the event to the ICAO WACAF Regional Office to facilitate application for entry visa on arrival at the Blaise Diagne International Airport.

9. Health

- 9.1. Health control measures related to Covid-19 were lifted on 10 November 2022. These provisions are likely to change with little notice depending on the health situation. It is therefore strongly recommended to check before any trip to Senegal the conditions that apply with the airline with which you plan to travel.
- 9.2. Participants are informed that a valid certificate of vaccination against yellow fever is required.
- 9.3. The participants should ensure that they have applied for valid health insurance for the coverage of any medical care during their stay in Senegal.

10. Banks and Currency

10.1. Banks are located not far from the course venue and are open from 07:40 to 12:15 hours and 13:40 to 15:45 hours from Monday to Friday and could be opened on Saturday morning. Local currency in CFA Franc (XOF) and the exchange rate is approximately 600 XOF for 1 USD, subject to fluctuation.

11. Accommodation and transport

- 11.1. Participants are required to make their own reservation online or on phone to the hotel of their choice.
- 11.2. They are also informed that no transport service will be made available.

12. Electricity

12.1. The sockets and plugs used in Senegal are type C. The voltage is 230 volts, and the frequency is 50 Hz. It is therefore necessary to provide adapters when your equipment uses different electrical outlets.
