#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

#### 1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 According to the Programme document, the Steering Committee shall meet at least once a year, normally in the country of its Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson or elsewhere if not possible for the meeting to be held in the country of the Steering Committee's current Chairpersons.
- 1.2 Its roles and responsibilities are among others to formulate priorities to provide overall direction to the Programme, approve the operating plan, the budget, the reports and assess the Programme performances.
- 1.3 The Steering Committee meeting is conducted in English and is chaired by the Chairperson and the Vice-Chairperson. As clearly outlined in the Phase III Programme document, "the steering committee can only take decisions during a meeting if a quorum of at least one third of the steering committee members with voting rights is reached."
- 1.4 The objective of this working paper is to review the list of the Programme members with voting rights attending the current meeting and decide on its validity.



#### 2. **DISCUSSION**

- 2.1 As per the provisions of Appendix D of the Programme document (Steering Committee Rules), the Steering Committee is composed of the Project Members. The Project members include the active members, the users, the host administration, the donors, the cooperating agencies, and the implementing agencies.
- 2.2 The active members are members who have paid at list one annual financial contribution to the Programme and whose arrears do not exceed the amount of three (3) annual contributions (cf SC/7-Dec14).
- 2.3 The types of membership, the commitments and the corresponding number of votes are detailed in the table below.

- 2.4 Airbus assisted the Programme during Phase I with in-kind and financial contributions.
- 2.5 The list of member States with their arrears as of 31 December 2024 is presented in the Attachment A.
- 2.6 Taking into account the host administration, the donors, the cooperating agency and the implementing agencies (4), the total number of members with voting rights is 42 voters. This number is compared with the number of participants with voting rights attending the meeting in the below table.
