1. AFRICAN FPP OBJECTIVES FOR 2022 – 2023

- 1.1 As highlighted in working paper 6.4, the work programme is tailored to meet the set objectives of the Project, address the needs of the members and tackle emerging deficiencies. The proposed programme is divided into three parts:
 - Trainings and workshops;
 - Flight procedure design projects; and
 - Other assistance activities.

1.2 **Training and workshops**

- 1.2.1 Based on the ICAO SARPs and technical guidance material, the courses and workshops aim to support participating members in developing their PANS-OPS or PANS-OPS related areas by providing fundamental knowledge in these domains. The instruction consists of lecturing, exercises, progress tests and examinations for the trainings, case studies for the workshops.
- 1.2.2 The cost of these activities may be supported by AFPP funds, ICAO or jointly by participating members and the AFPP (cost sharing).

1.2.3 A full airspace design workshop encompassing the entire spectrum of the airspace design (flexible use of airspace (FUA), Free route airspace, parallel routing, CCO/CDO) is proposed. This activity is costly because outsourced and therefore request involvement many actors for the funding.

1.3 Flight procedure design projects

- 1.3.1 As the AFPP is a non-profit programme, the flight procedure design projects are based on cost-recovery; the main objective is to assist participating members with insufficient flight procedure design capability in meeting their commitments under ICAO Resolution A37-11 for Performance-Based Navigation (PBN) and their obligations with regards to the quality of their instrument flight procedures (IFPs). Additionally, for these members, all types of flight procedures may be concerned (visual approach, conventional flight procedures, CCO/CDO, etc.). The work is done using a pool of experts seconded to the Programme. A full pack is generally proposed:
 - Design;
 - Awareness training for ATM personnel, including Quality assurance training;
 - Assistance for safety assessment, regulatory approval and publication.
- 1.3.2 The list of the ongoing projects provided in the table below does not prevent the processing of new requests emanating from participating members. It gives live on-the-job training opportunity for the designers who have been trained theoretically to be involved in and gain experience and confidence.
