### **GOLD** status

- 14 June 2010 GOLD, First Edition, issued
- 25 June 2010 North Atlantic (NAT) SPG/46 adopts GOLD
- 28 June 2010 State letter from ICAO Asia-Pacific Regional Director adopts GOLD
  - recalled that APANPIRG/20 (September 2009) concluded to adopt the GOLD upon its release
  - requested administrations "to promulgate GOLD to ADS/CPDLC system users including aircraft operators and air navigation service providers for them to make full use of the document"



# **GOLD** status (continued)

- All subordinate ATS coordinating groups (formal and informal) in NAT and the Asia-Pacific Regions have adopted the GOLD
- 18 May 2010 South Atlantic FIT supports GOLD
- GOLD supersedes
  - FANS 1/A Operations Manual (FOM)
  - Guidance Material for ATS Data Link Services in North Atlantic Airspace (NAT Data Link GM)



# **GOLD** status (continued)

- 25 Nov 2010 European Air Navigation Planning Group (EANPG) mandated the Programme Coordination Group (COG) to
  - Address the practical aspects of harmonization of the LINK2000+ Operational Guidance and GOLD documents
  - Establish a mechanism to advance this work
  - Report to EANPG/53 (Nov 2011)



### **GOLD** – benefits

- It is being accepted WORLDWIDE
- It provides cost-effective and practical solutions to advance safety, improve efficiency, and save the environment
  - Harmonizes implementation for seamless operations
  - Provides guidance material to facilitate implementation
  - Contributes to safe application of reduced separations
  - Provides a baseline for next generation data link (NextGen)
- It has buy-in from those who plan for, implement, provide and use data link services daily
  - They are using it! They want to use it!




# GOLD contents – guidance material

- Service provision
- Operator preparation and aircraft equipage
- Controller and flight crew procedures
- RCP and surveillance performance specifications
- Post-implementation monitoring and corrective action



# Post-implementation monitoring







## **GOLD** implementation considerations

#### Examples

- Specific ANSP registration procedures for aircraft operators
- Operational authorizations to use data link
- Awareness of GOLD procedures
- Proposals for Amendments to Regional Supplementary Procedures (SUPPs) and aeronautical charts
- Post-implementation monitoring and corrective action
- Position reporting requirements and ADS contract management
- Items specific to any airspace user or Region



### **Candidates for GOLD amendments**

#### Procedures

- Report severe and moderate turbulence (JCAB)
- ADS-B in trail procedures (ITP) (Airbus, SC214/WG78)
- ADS-C climb/descent procedures (CDP) (GOLD Editor)
- Reroutes (NAT)
- ADS-C out-of-conformance inquiries and instructions (NAT)
- Revised estimated time of arrival (ETA) (Delta)
- CPDLC use in airspace with VHF coverage (Delta)
- Oceanic clearance (NAT, Portugal)
- Departure clearance & other ACARS applications (AEEC DLUF)



### **Candidates for GOLD amendments**

#### Post-implementation monitoring

 Clarify analysis of outages, notifications, and missing ADS-C reports (U.S., New Zealand)

#### Region specific

- Include focal points for CTA/FIR (Nav Canada)
- AIDC capability (Operators)
- DARP (Operators)
- Add new CTA/FIRs as Regions become participants (GOLD Editor)

#### Expansion

- African-Indian Ocean (AFI) and South American (SAM) Regions (SAT/FIT)
- European (EUR) Region (Maastricht UAC)





## Follow-on activity

- GOLD/3 Ad Hoc Working Group agreed to assist Regions in managing amendments to the GOLD after its release
- Follow-on work
  - Solicit proposals for amendments to the GOLD
  - Coordinate proposed amendments across the regions
  - Provide interpretation and further clarification to GOLD guidelines
  - Facilitate implementation of standardized data link operations, postimplementation monitoring, and corrective actions
  - Develop a proposal for ICAO on establishing a global configuration management process for the GOLD



### Processing proposed amendments

- All participating regions must accept any proposal for amendment
- Use processes and forum similar to change processes used prior to the First Edition
  - Master comment matrix
  - Proposed amendment packages
  - Teleconferences/Web Ex sessions
  - Meetings will be arranged, as needed



# **Envisaged change cycle**

### GOLD editions – every two years

- APANPIRG meets annually in September
- NAT SPG meets annually in June

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#### GOLD amendments – when needed

 An amendment could be accepted as an individual package until such time that it is incorporated into a new edition of the GOLD



## Summary

- GOLD has been adopted by North Atlantic, Asia, and Pacific Regions and portions of the African-Indian Ocean (AFI) Region – 46 FIRs/CTAs
- Supersedes the FOM and NAT Data Link GM
- Plans for adoption within the entire AFI, South American and European Regions
- Jan 2011 solicited updates to GOLD work program
  - Address implementation considerations
  - Identify candidate proposals for amendment to the GOLD
