(Backup procedures for AFI RODBs)

Procedure steps	Description	Supporting Document(s)
1	First, both AFI RODBs shall adopt and maintain a common catalogue for any backup procedure to be implemented.	AFI Bulletin and station catalogues
2	In the event where one of the AFI RODB goes down, the manager of the affected RODB shall notify without delay both the AFI AMBEX Bulletin Compiling Centers (AMBEX BCCs) and the manager of the other RODB.	Appendix G - AFI AMBEX Handbook
3	The BCCs under the responsibility of the affected RODB shall re-route the bulletins to RODB which is not affected using the correct AFTN address.	Appendix A&B - AFI AMBEX Handbook
4	The RODB which will be operational will then compile and promulgate bulletins required as per the latest AFI AMBEX Handbook routine tables. 5	Correct bulletin headers as described the AFI AMBEX Handbook shall be used when bulletins are compiled by one RODB on behalf of another.	Appendix A&B - AFI AMBEX Handbook
