


I - INTRODUCTION




NIAMEY AFTN CENTRE



BRAZZAVILLE AFTN CENTRE




LIBREVILLE AFTN CENTRE








DJAMENA AFTN CENTRE




ABIDJAN AFTN CENTRE




COTONOU AFTN CENTRE

- The Analysis of AFTN circuits availability from January, 2009 to April ,2010 point out a fairly good working of the circuits , however, a number of links are to be improved in term of stability and availability

II - COMMENTS(2)

- With the actions undertaken jointly by ASECNA GCAA and NAMA in Ghana and Nigeria the majority of circuits have been restored and have become more reliable :
 - DLA/KNO;
 - LBV/ACC
 - LBV/KNO
 - DLA/LOS;
 - NIM/KNO;
 - NIM/ACC.

II - COMMENTS(3)

- However, some links are to be improved :
 - KNO/BZV;
 - BZV/ACC.
 - ABJ/ACC
 - NDJ/MDG
 - NDJ/DLA
- Despite the correct availability of some circuits, centres continue to experience lack of flight plan

III – CONCLUSION(1)

- The meeting is invited to:
 - note the above information related to the FTN working on AFISNET
 - Reinforce co-operation between COM Centres in technical and operational domain
 - Expedite regular surveys regarding lack of flight plan messages
 - encourage all SNMC COM centres to exchange on a regular basis, the information on their AFTN circuit status and make a common analysis.
