1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 At its Fourth meeting in Mahé, Seychelles 20 to 22 February 2012, FPLT TF/4 was formed a small working group SWG-Publications to develop draft NOTAM guidance that would be made available to States for use in introducing the NEW FPL. As agreed by the Task Force, the SWG-Publications completed its work outside the meeting and the NOTAM Template, copy of which at **Appendix A** to this working paper was forwarded to States under State Letter ES AN 4/45 – 0317 dated 4 April 2012.

1.2 The EUR/NAT Region has developed an AIC Template with the same objective as the FPLT TF/4 and has made it available to other Regions.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 The AIC Template developed by the EUR/NAT Region has been adapted for consideration by the FPLT TF/5 in the context of the AFI Region, and is provided at **Appendix B** to this working paper.

2.2 The meeting may wish to review the material at Appendix B in conjunction with the NOTAM Template at Appendix A, for consideration as material that could also be made available, with or without modifications, to AFI States.

- b) request the Regional Offices to distribute the Publications guidance developed by the Task Force to States for their consideration.
