

# Security information



- Senegal is at Security Level 2 – Low
- The use of public transport buses called “Car Rapide”, “Ndiaga Ndiaye” and “Tata” is not recommended;
- Use legal taxis (license plates on the front doors), make sure you are the only customer and negotiate/agree on the price of the ride before embarking
- Avoid walking alone and on foot after dark and avoid isolated areas;
- Watch out for pickpockets and bag snatching;
- With the exception of AIBD Airport commuting, road travel between main cities outside of Dakar is not allowed between 19h00 and 06h00.
