Priority Focus by all Stakeholders

- One common language
- Simple concept but complex implementation
- Standardisation compliance with ICAO SARPs & guidance
- Time start implementation now
- Change safety management
- Personnel training specific and multi-stakeholder; different types including practical workshops and OJT
- Teamwork collaboration of all stakeholders

ICAO

- Focus on RCR provisions terminology to avoid confusion by referring to GRF
- ICAO Regional Office supports States implementation
- International and regional organizations and industry to support ICAO, States and Service Providers
- Make use of regional mechanisms (COSCAPs, RSOOs, RASG-AFI Go-Teams, ...)
- Establish a regional and global mechanism to monitor the status of implementation
- Global implementation status monitoring mechanism

States

- Promulgate regulations, guidance & train inspectors
- Notify to ICAO and publish differences if any
- Complete State level safety risk assessment
- Develop national implementation plan
- Appoint implementation focal point
- Establish implementation team including regulator, service providers, industry/professional associations, military, ...
- Organise national workshop and safety promotion
- Conduct trial prior to applicability

Aerodrome Operators and ANSPs

- Commence implementation preparation
- Consider using airport Runway Safety Teams structure for implementation planning, coordination, support, follow-up, monitoring, reporting
- Complete airport level safety risk assessment under SMS including ATS
- Prepare to issue SNOWTAMs for standing water
- Complete the ICAO/ACI online training GRF course
- Conduct airport level On-the-Job Training (OJT)
- Assistance is available from ICAO Runway Safety Go-Teams and ACI APEX Safety Reviews

Aircraft Operators

- Ensure training of flight crews and dispatchers
- Complete airline safety risk assessment under SMS
- Update manuals
- Promote safety importance with airports, ANSPs and States
- IATA, ... to support airlines
