5. Documentation

5.1. The training will be paperless and all related documentation will be posted at www.icao.int/WACAF/Pages/PANS-OPS.aspx and www.icao.int/wacaf/african-fpp. Participants are advised to bring their laptops.

6. Weather

6.1. The mean temperature in Dakar is 28° in June and the weather could be subject to rain showers. The local time in Senegal is UTC.

7. Entry visas

7.1. Senegalese visas are obtainable at Senegal Embassies or consulates in their country. Participants from States without Senegalese foreign missions are required to send a copy of their passports at least one month prior to the event to the ICAO WACAF regional office to facilitate application for entry visa on arrival at the Blaise Diagne International Airport.

8. Health

- 8.1. Health control measures related to Covid-19 were lifted on 10 November 2022. These provisions are likely to change with little notice depending on the health situation. It is therefore strongly recommended to check before any trip to Senegal the conditions that apply with the airline with which you plan to travel.
- 8.2. Participants are informed that a valid certificate of vaccination against yellow fever is required.
- 8.3. The participants should ensure that they have applied for valid health insurance for the coverage of any medical care during their stay in Senegal.

9. Banks and Currency

9.1. Banks are located not far from the course venue and are open from 07:40 to 12:15 hours and 13:40 to 15:45 hours from Monday to Friday and could be opened on Saturday morning. Local currency in CFA Franc (XOF) and the exchange rate is approximately 600 XOF for 1 USD, subject to fluctuation.

10. Accommodation and transport

- 10.1. A list of recommended hotels is attached hereto, and participants are required to make their own reservation online or on phone to the hotel of their choice from the list of hotels.
- 10.2. Participants are informed that no transport service will be made available from the hotels to the course place.

11. Socket type

- 11.1. The power plugs and outlets used in Senegal are the types C or E.
- 11.2. The type C plug has two round pins. It is commonly known as the "Euro" plug, and its socket can work with the types E or F plugs.
- 11.3. The type E plug has two round pins, along with a hole for the type E make socket earthling pin. Senegal operates on a 230 V supply voltage and 50 Hz
