SUMMARY

This paper provides a status report on the implementation of Conclusions and Decisions of the Second Meeting of the Regional Aviation Safety Group for Africa and the Indian Ocean Region (RASG-AFI/2).

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Subsequent to the Second meeting of the Regional Aviation Safety Group for the AFI region, the Secretariat circulated the final Report of the meeting including the Conclusions and Decisions.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 The RASG-AFI/2 meeting adopted nine (9) Decisions and eleven (11) Conclusions; as shown in the attached **Appendix** which provides the status of implementation of the actions derived from them.

2.2 The activities of the RASG-AFI are mainly categorized under the framework of the four Safety Support Teams (SSTs) so as to promote AFI safety performance and attainment of the regional safety targets in a sustainable manner.

2.3. Although progress has been made in the implementation of the activities, it is important to note that some of the activities are continual in nature and therefore their status of implementation remains on-going.
