RASG-AFI EI

World average

- From 55.72% last year to 57.79% in 2023

- From 67.50% to 68.9%

Challenges

LEG and CE-2

Online Framework

- Processes for the amendment of specific operating regulations
 - Identification and notification of differences to ICAO
 - Regulations on AIG
 - Regulations on RPAS/UAS
- Updating on a regular basis the modules of the USOAP CMA Online Framework

Challenges

Areas of lowest EI

Lowest EIs for CEs

- AIG from 41% last year to 44.03% in 2023
- AGA from 46% to 47.6%
- ANS from 52% to 53.54%
5 SSCs in ANS
- OPS 56% to 58.2%.

- CE-4 from 53% to 56%
- CE-6 from 54% to 56.15%
- CE-8 from 32% to 32.86%
- CE-7 from 43% to 43.07%

Challenges SSP

- Nine States have not yet started a Gap analysis
- One State reported a full implementation of the SSP.
- Lack of an effective safety reporting system
- lack sufficient data
- Identification of operational safety risks
- limited engagement of stakeholders and lack of communication

Possible solutions

LEG and CE-2

- Clear rulemaking process to amend in a timely manner their specific regulations
- Identify and notify any differences to ICAO
- Regulations on AIG
- Regulations on RPAS/UAS
- Harmonization of States regulatory frameworks

Possible solutions

CE-4

- Effective financial autonomy of civil aviation administrations and accident investigation authorities
- Stakeholders should assist States on specialized training and immersion learning
- Technical assistance projects and capacity building

CE-6

- Documented process with thorough evaluation of applicants' documents
- Processes for granting specific approvals
- Pooling and sharing of Resources
- Harmonization of regulatory frameworks for certifications, licensing and approvals obligations
- Calibration of navigation aids and validation of flight procedures

Possible solutions

CE-7 Surveillance

- OPS, ANS and AGA
- Risk-based
- Exchange of safety data and information
- Delegation of functions

CE-8 Resolution of safety issues

- PEL, OPS, AIR, AIG, ANS and AGA

Possible solutions

SSP

- allocate more resources,
- involve all aviation authorities and stakeholders and clearly establish responsibilities
- accountabilities for the implementation and maintenance.
- safety management training, SSP/SMS instructors training
- establishment of effective safety data collecting and processing systems
- exchange safety information

ACTION BY THE MEETING

- a) take note of the information and progress made
- b) address challenges in a more collaborative manner through the allocation and pooling of resources and by sharing data and safety critical information
- c) provide more trainings in the most critical areas namely OPS, AIG, ANS and AGA
