ICAO Behaviour Detection Course Malé, Maldives Revised date: 13 – 17 October 2024

I am pleased to inform you that CASP-AP, in conjunction with the Directorate of Aviation Security Administration (DASA) Maldives, will conduct an *ICAO Behaviour Detection Course* in Malé, Maldives from 13 – 17 October 2024.

This five-day course is designed to provide security personnel, and those responsible for the implementation of aviation security measures, with effective behaviour detection techniques and methods in order to enhance overall protection against acts of unlawful interference.

The target population should be Security personnel responsible for the development, implementation, supervision or oversight of aviation security measures, to include:

- Personnel of a civil aviation authority responsible for aviation security;
- Personnel from other regulatory authorities, law enforcement agencies, airports, airlines, and/or service providers that have an active role in maintaining aviation and airport security; and
- Aviation security instructors who are or will be responsible for delivering this or similar subject matter.
