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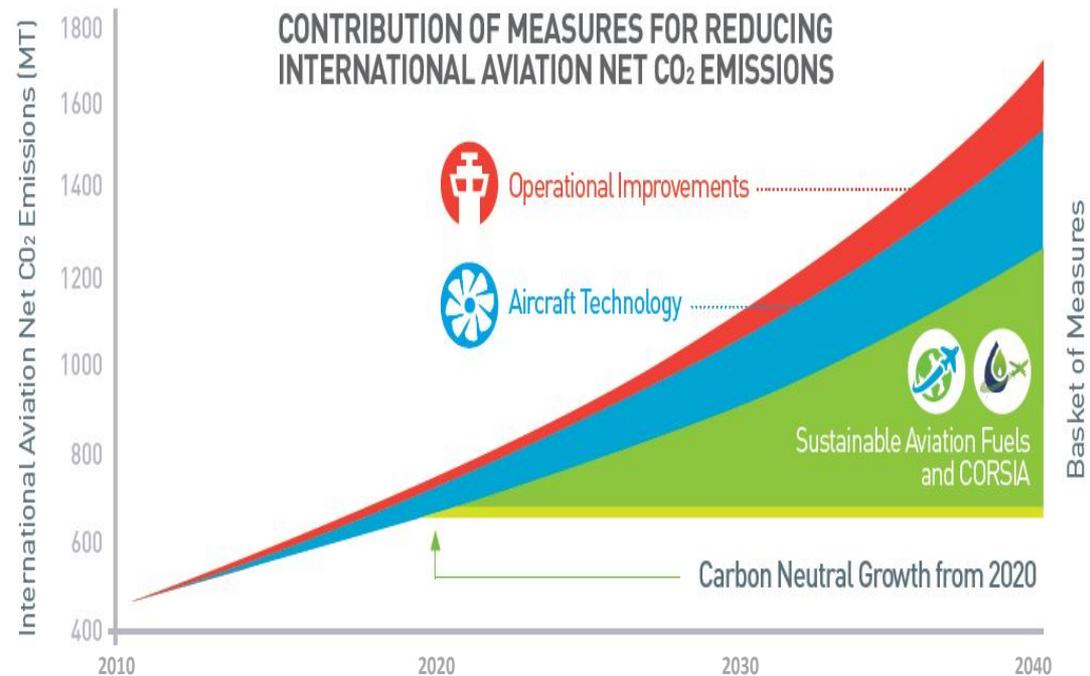




CORSIA was adopted by the 39th ICAO Assembly in 2016 through ICAO Assembly Resolution 39-3 The **first global MBM scheme** for any industry sector

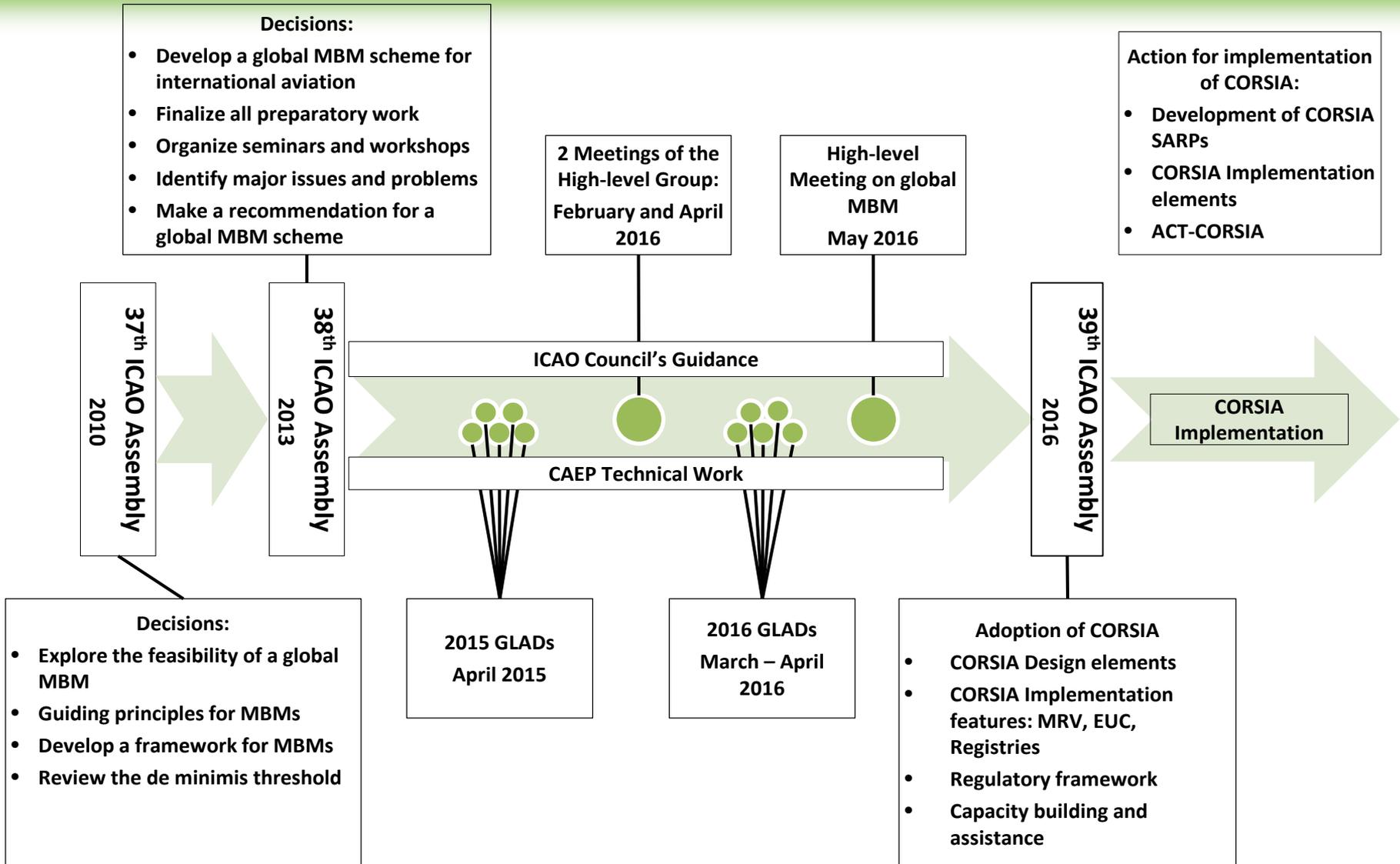
To achieve ICAO's global aspirational goal of carbon neutral growth from 2020 (CNG 2020), CORSIA is **one complementary element in the basket of measures to:**

- **aircraft technology**
- **operational improvements**
- **sustainable aviation fuels**





- CORSIA Design used a Staged Approach over Time:
 - Choice of Mechanism
 - Select the Goal
 - Define CORSIA Key design elements
 - Outreach for Global Awareness
 - Development CORSIA Technical Elements
 - Approval Process
 - Outreach for Global Implementation (since 2018)
 - Implementation (NOW)





- **CORSIA Key design elements:**
 - Phased implementation
 - Emissions coverage: route-based approach
 - Offsetting requirements and offsetting reduction options
 - New entrants
 - Technical exemptions
 - Review mechanism



- **CORSIA Technical features:**
 - Monitoring, Reporting and Verification
 - Emissions Unit Criteria
 - Use of CORSIA Eligible Fuels to Reduce Obligations
