- Committed to taking action
- Honouring our responsibilities under the Paris Agreement and the Doha Amendment to the Kyoto Protocol
- Taking action to reduce domestic emissions and support international initiatives

Climate change initiatives – funding and assistance

- AU\$1 billion over the next five years to address climate change
 - Including \$300 million to support Pacific countries
- Support structured around three themes
 - Research
 - Resilience
 - Risk reduction and response

Examples of funding and initiatives

- Monitoring, reporting and verification
 - Global Forest Observations Initiative (GOFI)
- International Partnership on Blue Carbon
 - Including \$6 million for the Pacific Regional Blue Carbon initiative

Aviation specific assistance

- CORSIA Regional Seminar
 - including supporting attendance of a number of Pacific countries
- Committed to other CORSIA capacity building assistance for the region
 - working together on the nature of that assistance

Industry initiatives

- Airports
 - Airport carbon accreditation scheme
 - Initiatives at Adelaide, Darwin, Alice Springs and Canberra
- Air space management
 - Asia and South Pacific Initiative to reduce emissions (ASPIRE)
- Airlines
 - Fleet management
 - Voluntary offsetting program
