

PHASE II OF THE ICAO ASSISTANCE PROJECT WITH EU FUNDING

Capacity Building for CO₂ Mitigation from International Aviation

Following the achievements of Phase I, ICAO has launched Phase II of the **Capacity Building for CO₂ Mitigation from International Aviation** project and development of State Action Plans for 10 States in Africa, funded by the European Union. The second phase has a total cost of EUR 1.5 million.

1 SHARED GOAL

Scale up the impact of climate change mitigation measures by implementing capacity-building activities that further support the development of low-carbon air transport and contribute to environmental sustainability.


Assist the participating States in developing and submitting their State Action Plans on emissions reduction.


