1. INTRODUCTION


1.1 The FAA Technical Center developed a video to assist in cabin crew training that demonstrates how dangerous lithium battery fires can be. Emergency procedures on how to deal with fires when they occur in the cabin are not fully described in the emergencies response guides. This has caused concern among cabin crews. The United States hopes that this video can help other States to demonstrate the dangerous that may occur from lithium batteries aboard an aircraft.
