PACKING INSTRUCTION 370

(Presented by K. Vermeersch)

SUMMARY

This working paper contains a proposal to align the packing requirements of Packing Instruction 370 with Y370.

Action by the DGP: The DGP is invited to amend Packing Instruction 370 as shown in the appendix to this working paper.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Packing Instruction Y370 for UN 3269 contains the following compatibility requirement:

Metal packagings must be corrosion resistant or be protected against corrosion for substances with a Class 8 subsidiary risk.

Packing instruction 370 for UN 3269 (**Polyester resin kit**) however, does not contain this compatibility requirement. As it is felt that this is an omission, it is proposed to align the two packing instructions.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

Part 4

PACKING INSTRUCTIONS

...

Packing Instruction 370

Passenger and cargo aircraft for UN 3269 (Packing Group II or III) only

General requirements

Part 4, Chapter 1 requirements must be met, including:

1) **Compatibility requirements**

— Substances must be compatible with their packagings as required by 4;1.1.3.

— Metal packagings must be corrosion resistant or be protected against corrosion for substances with a Class 8 subsidiary risk.
