REPLACEMENT OF "EXEMPTION" WITH "EXCEPTION" IN PART 2, CHAPTER 2

(Presented by D. Brennan)

SUMMARY

Part 2, Chapter 2 regarding classification of gases includes some exceptions from classification for some gases under defined circumstances. The note in Part 2;2.2.3 however refers to "exemption". It is proposed to replace this with "exception".

Action by the DGP: The DGP is invited to support the revision to the note under Part 2;2.2.3 as shown in the appendix to this working paper.

1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 The 2015-2016 Edition of the Technical Instructions included new provisions in Part 1;2.6 for lamps. Associated with the new provision was the addition of a new note to Part 2;2.2.3 that identified that the exceptions from classification in Division 2.2 did not apply to lamps.
- 1.2 The text in Part 1;2.6 and the note under Part 2;2.2.6 were all adopted from changes to the 18th revised edition of the *UN Model Regulations*. However, the text in the note uses the term "exemption", which in the Technical Instructions has very specific meaning as set out in Part 1;1.1.3 and as defined in Part 1;3.1.
- 1.3 It is believed that the correct word to use in the note is "exception", which widely used in the Technical Instructions to indicate that as provided for, the provisions of the Technical Instructions do not apply.

2. **ACTION BY THE DGP**

2.1 The DGP is invited to support the revision to the note under Part 2;2.2.3 as shown in the appendix to this working paper.

2.2 DIVISIONS

. . .

- 2.2.3 Gases of Division 2.2 are not subject to these Instructions when contained in the following:
- a) foodstuffs, including carbonated beverages (except UN 1950);
- b) balls intended for use in sports; or
- c) tyres which meet the provisions of Special Provision A59.

Note.— This exemption exception does not apply to lamps. For lamps see 1;2.6.
