**EDITORIAL: ICAO TI's FIGURE 5-25 - RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL,  
CLASS 7, PLACARD FOR LARGE FREIGHT CONTAINERS**

**1. BACKGROUND**

1.1 There is a difference between the requirements of Part 5;3.5.1.2 and Figure 5-25 in the 2001/2002 edition of the ICAO Technical Instructions. One text requires the black line, which is to appear at the edge of the Class 7 placard for freight containers, to be 5mm from the edge the other, requires it to be 12.5 mm from the edge.

1.2 This inconsistency between the two requirements is carried over to the 2003/2004 ICAO Technical Instructions.

It was noted that Section 5.3.1.2.2 of the 12 th edition UN Recommendations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods – Model Regulations indicates that 5mm is the distance this line must be from the edge of the placard.

**2. PROPOSAL**

2.1 Issue a corrigendum to the ICAO Technical Instructions, 2003/2004 edition amending the appropriate text in Figure 5-25 - Radioactive material, Class 7, placard for large freight containers to correspond to the narrative text of Part 5;3.5.1.2 of the ICAO TI's, 2003/2004.
