REVISION TO THE LIST OF DANGEROUS GOODS THAT DO NOT NEED TO BE LISTED ON THE NOTOC

SUMMARY

This working paper proposes to add UN 3164 — Articles, pressurized, hydraulic containing non-flammable gas and UN 3164 — Articles, pressurized, pneumatic containing non-flammable gas to the list of dangerous goods not required to appear in the information to the pilot-incommand contained in Table 7-9.

Action by the DGP-WG is in paragraph 2.

1. **INTRODUCTION**

1.1 UN 3164 — Articles, pressurized, hydraulic containing non-flammable gas and UN 3164 — Articles, pressurized, pneumatic containing non-flammable gas, do not need to be listed with the information to pilot-in-command (NOTOC) when Packing Instruction 208 a) applies:

Packing Instruction 208

The general packing requirements of 4;1 must be met.

Articles, pressurized pneumatic or hydraulic containing a non-flammable, non-liquefied and non-toxic gas and constructed from materials which will not fragment under pressure, may be carried under the following conditions:

a) when installed in construction equipment and assembled machinery, articles must be designed and constructed with a burst pressure of not less than 5 times their charged pressure at 21°C when shipped;
Note.— Labelling, marking, dangerous goods transport document and information to pilot-in-command are not required.

1.2 UN 3164 is not listed in the list of dangerous goods not required to appear in the information to the pilot-in-command contained in Table 7-9 of the Technical Instructions. The inconsistency may easily cause misunderstanding.

2. **ACTION BY THE DGP-WG**

2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to consider the proposed amendments to Table 7-9 shown in the appendix to this working paper.
