2.7: Part 7 — Operator's Responsibilities

TRANSPORT INDEX LIMIT UNDER EXCLUSIVE USE

SUMMARY

This paper proposes an amendment to Part 7;2.9.3.3b) of the *Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air* to clarify that there may be a limit on the sum of transport indexes as a result of separation distances.

Action by the DGP-WG is in paragraph 2.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Part 7;2.9.3.3b) of the Technical Instructions states:

“Where a consignment is transported under exclusive use, there is no limit on the sum of the transport indexes aboard a single aircraft;”

1.2 It is suggested that without any further clarification, the above wording could be misinterpreted as suggesting that limits on transport indexes as a result of the separation requirements do not apply. This can be rectified by a simple cross reference to Part 7;2.9.6 of the Technical Instructions.

2. ACTION BY THE DGP-WG

2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to consider the following amendment to Part 7; 2.9.3.3b):

Where a consignment is transported under exclusive use, there is no limit on the sum of the transport indexes aboard an aircraft except as required by 2.9.6:
