TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR AIRLINES NOT HOLDING AN APPROVAL TO CARRY DANGEROUS GOODS

SUMMARY

This working paper proposes the addition of a new Table 1-5 in order to clarify and to refine the training requirements for operators not holding an approval to carry dangerous goods.

Action by the DGP-WG is in paragraph 2.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 A proposal to refine the training requirements for operators not carrying dangerous goods as cargo was very much supported by the members of DGP-WG/06 (DGP-WG/06-WP/48). At that time the working group favoured the second option, the development of an additional table in the Technical Instructions.

2. ACTION BY THE DGP-WG

2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to consider adding a new paragraph to Part 1;4.2 as follows:

4.2.7 Staff of operators not holding an approval to carry dangerous goods must be trained commensurate with their responsibilities. The subject matter to which their various categories of staff should be familiar with is indicated in Table 1-5.
