LITHIUM BATTERY OUTREACH

SUMMARY

The working group is invited to consider proposals to produce educational video material on the subject of lithium batteries, which would be made freely available.

Action by the DGP-WG is in paragraph 2.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 At DGP/22, the panel agreed that efforts should be made by all Contracting States to improve education and outreach activities related to the safe transport by air of lithium batteries. In the United Kingdom, it has been decided to produce educational video material, which will be made freely available to States, operators and others for use on web sites, training material, airport check in areas etc. It is envisaged that approximately five minutes of video will be produced and whilst no structure has yet been decided upon, it is thought that it would be useful if the material could be divided into sections addressing the various parties e.g. shippers, senders (mail) and passengers, enabling only the relevant section to be viewed as appropriate.

2. ACTION BY THE DGP-WG

2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to comment on whether such an initiative would be of use. Depending on the level of support, it is proposed to hold a lunchtime or evening working group to consider those aspects which members believe are important to be reflected in the video.
