SUMMARY

This paper proposes amendment to Part 5;1.1 a) to replace the word 'prohibited' with the word 'forbidden'.

Action by the DGP-WG is in paragraph 2.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Part 5;1.1 a) uses the word 'prohibited' in reference to items in 1;2.

1.2 Part 1;2.1 relates to dangerous goods forbidden for transport by air under any circumstances.

1.3 The convention in use of the word 'forbidden' is made to ensure consistency of meaning throughout the Technical Instructions.

2. ACTION BY THE DGP-WG

2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to:

a) consider replacing the word 'prohibited' with the word 'forbidden' in 5;1.1 a)

5;1.1 a)

1.1 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Before a person offers any package or overpack of dangerous goods for transport by air that person must ensure that:

- a) the articles or substances are not ~~prohibited~~ forbidden for transport by air (see Part 1, Chapter 2);
