TRAINING OF OPERATORS NOT CARRYING DANGEROUS GOODS

SUMMARY

This paper proposes to modify the title of Table 1-5 to clarify to whom it applies.

Action by the DGP-WG is in paragraph 2.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Part 1;4.2.7 of the Technical Instructions specifies the required training for the staff of operators not carrying dangerous goods as cargo, mail or stores.

4.2.7 Staff of operators not carrying dangerous goods as cargo, mail or stores must be trained commensurate with their responsibilities. The subject matter to which their various categories of staff should be familiar with is indicated in Table 1-5.

1.2 The present title of Table 1-5: “Table 1-5. Content of training courses for operators not carrying dangerous goods as cargo” might lead a person to believe that operators that do not carry dangerous goods as stores or mail would not require dangerous goods training.

2. ACTION BY THE DGP-WG

2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to consider revising the title of Table 1-5 as follows:
