SUMMARY

This working papers seeks guidance in developing an ICAO dangerous goods incident report system.

Action by the DGP-WG is in paragraph 2.

1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 In support of safety management systems, ICAO is placing considerable importance on data collection and analysis. During its review of the DGP/23 Report and the Report of the DGP Working Group of the Whole on Lithium Batteries, the Air Navigation Commission (ANC) asked the Secretariat to consider developing a dangerous goods incident reporting system with standardized methods and procedures for gathering and coordinating data.
- 1.2 Some panel members have already provided designs of incident data collection systems used within their States which can be used a s a basis for designing the ICAO system. Items to be considered include:
 - a) scope and objective;
 - b) definition of data elements to be collected;
 - c) standardized methods for collecting data;
 - d) standard report forms;

- e) origin of reports;
- f) access rights; and
- g) dissemination of information (to whom and how).

2. **ACTION BY THE DGP-WG**

2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to form a working group on incident data collection and to use the elements listed in paragraph 1.2 as a basis for discussion. Panel members who have incident reporting systems in their States and who haven't already shared their designs are invited to do so.
