BUNDLES OF CYLINDERS

(Presented by Micheline Paquette)

SUMMARY

This working paper proposes to modify the definition of "Bundles of cylinders" to include part of the definition found in the *UN Model Regulations*.

Action by the DGP-WG is in paragraph 2.

1. **INTRODUCTION**

1.1 Part 1;3 in the Technical Instructions provides a definition for "Bundles of cylinders". It states:

"Bundles of cylinders. (See UN Recommendations, Chapter 1.2). Not permitted for air transport."

- 1.2 The definition has created some confusion to cargo acceptance staff who assume when two or more cylinders are fastened to a pallet, they constitute a "bundle" (see Figure 1).
- 1.3 The definition found in the *UN Model Regulations* brings an important element in that the cylinders are interconnected by a manifold in addition to being fastened together. It states:

"Bundle of cylinders means an assembly of cylinders that are fastened together and which are interconnected by a manifold and transported as a unit. The total water capacity shall not exceed 3 000 litres except that bundles intended for the transport of gases of Division 2.3 shall be limited to 1 000 litres water capacity."

1.4 In order to avoid any further misunderstanding, we suggest that a portion of the definition of the UN recommendations be incorporated in the definition of the Technical Instructions.
