**TRANSPORT OF ARTICLE UN 1362 AS EXCEPTED QUANTITY**

(Presented by B. Carrara)

**SUMMARY**

This paper proposes an amendment on the allowance for transport of UN 1362 as an excepted quantity.

Action by the DGP-WG is in paragraph 2.

**1. INTRODUCTION**

1.1 The transport by air of UN 1362, **Carbon activated** is permitted in the Technical Instructions. Column 11 of Table 3-1 shows the maximum net quantity for articles or substances in each package for transport on a passenger aircraft and column 12 provides information similar to that in column 11, but for articles or substances which may be transported on a cargo aircraft only. Both columns specify the maximum net quantity of 0.5 kg per package for UN 1362.

1.2 Subparagraph d) of the note under Part 3;4.1.2 specifies that articles of Division 4.2 are not permitted as limited quantities. However this article is permitted as an excepted quantity as shown in column 9 of Table 3-1 for a total of 1 kg and inner packages of 30g (E1). This article is the only article where the maximum net quantity permitted by the packing instruction is less than the maximum net quantity in excepted quantity.

**2. ACTION BY THE DGP-WG**

2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to amend the code shown in column 9 of Table 3-1 for UN 1362 from E1 to E2 or E0, so that by the maximum quantity permitted in excepted quantities does not exceed the maximum amount permitted for passenger and cargo aircraft. The DGP-WG is invited to consider the proposals presented in the appendix to this working paper.
