
Commitment to Improvement

Focus on: Human Factors, Dialogue & Better Analysis

Human Factors

- Communication is critical to minimizing incursions and confusion
 - Direct warnings to pilots about other aircraft and vehicles on runway as well as movement areas

Dialogue

 Improving communication, education and knowledge sharing between controllers, pilots and ground vehicle operators

Better Analysis

 FAA is improving cross-organization coordination, data collection and analysis to address risks
