TRAINAIR *PLUS* GLOBAL SYMPOSIUM (SINGAPORE, 25 TO 28 SEPTEMBER 2012)

- 1. ICAO is pleased to invite your Government/Organization to participate in the first TRAINAIR *PLUS* Global Symposium which will be held in Singapore, from 25 to 28 September 2012. The Symposium, which will be free of charge, is being convened by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and will be hosted by the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS) and the Singapore Aviation Academy.
