



# Turkey-Africa Aviation Relations

## □ Turkey-Africa Civil Aviation Conference:

(30 May - 02 June 12 in Izmir)

- 180 Delegates from 31 Countries
- 23 New Agreements (BASA)
- 34 New Destinations

## □ Outcome:

50% Increase in passenger traffic between Turkey and Africa within 1 year.



# Turkey-Africa Aviation Relations

## □ Turk-Americas-African Civil Aviation Conference:

29 April – 01 May 2013 in Izmir:

- 80 Delegates from 28 Countries
- 10 New Agreements (BASA)
- 16 New Destinations
- Additional 150+ Frequencies



# Turkey-Africa Aviation Relations

## □ Training Programmes:

- \* The “*Emerging Countries Civil Aviation Training Programme*” in Oct. 2014.
- \* **Participants**: 18 Experts from 6 Countries
- \* **Expenses**: Provided by Turkish Cooperation & Coordination Office (TIKA)




# Turkish-ICAO Joint Efforts For Africa

- ❑ Aviation Safety in Africa is critical importance for Turkey.
- ❑ Qualified personnel is key & training demands of African States
- ❑ Either bilaterally or together with ICAO.
- ❑ Turkish DGCA is ready to contribute to ICAO efforts.
- ❑ Turkish Airlines' contribution:
  - 40 RT Tickets (50% off)
  - Use of ICAO AFI experts/personnel
  - THY network



# Turkish-ICAO Joint Efforts For Africa

- ❑ Contribution to the implementation of GASP
- ❑ MOU signed with ICAO on February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2015



# Candidature

- ❑ Turkey is candidate for ICAO Council at 2016 Elections.
- ❑ As a Council Member, Turkey will be able to;
  - play a more active role in the development of African Civil Aviation
  - provide more support and contribution to Africa
- ❑ **Stronger Africa, Stronger Turkey...**



# 5. EUROCONTROL



## ❑ First Contact in Dakar (May 2014)

- Committed to provide training/workshop on AIS



## ❑ In 2014, 2 AIS trainings took place

- DR Congo, 28-31 July, 40 Participants (CAA/ANSP)
- Angola, 24-28 November, 35 Participants (ANSP AIS)

## ❑ Agreement between EUROCONTROL & IATA

- To support Africa & improve AIS/AIM with workshops per State/ANSP
- Looking forward to signing MOU soon



# 5. EUROCONTROL



## ❑ Planned activities in 2015

- Training on AIS/AIM is foreseen in **Nigeria** (July/Aug 2015)
- Following 2 workshops for **DR Congo** and **Angola** still to be planned.

(Review implementation of AIS/AIM action plan proposed)

## ❑ Close cooperation with AFCAC Secretariat
