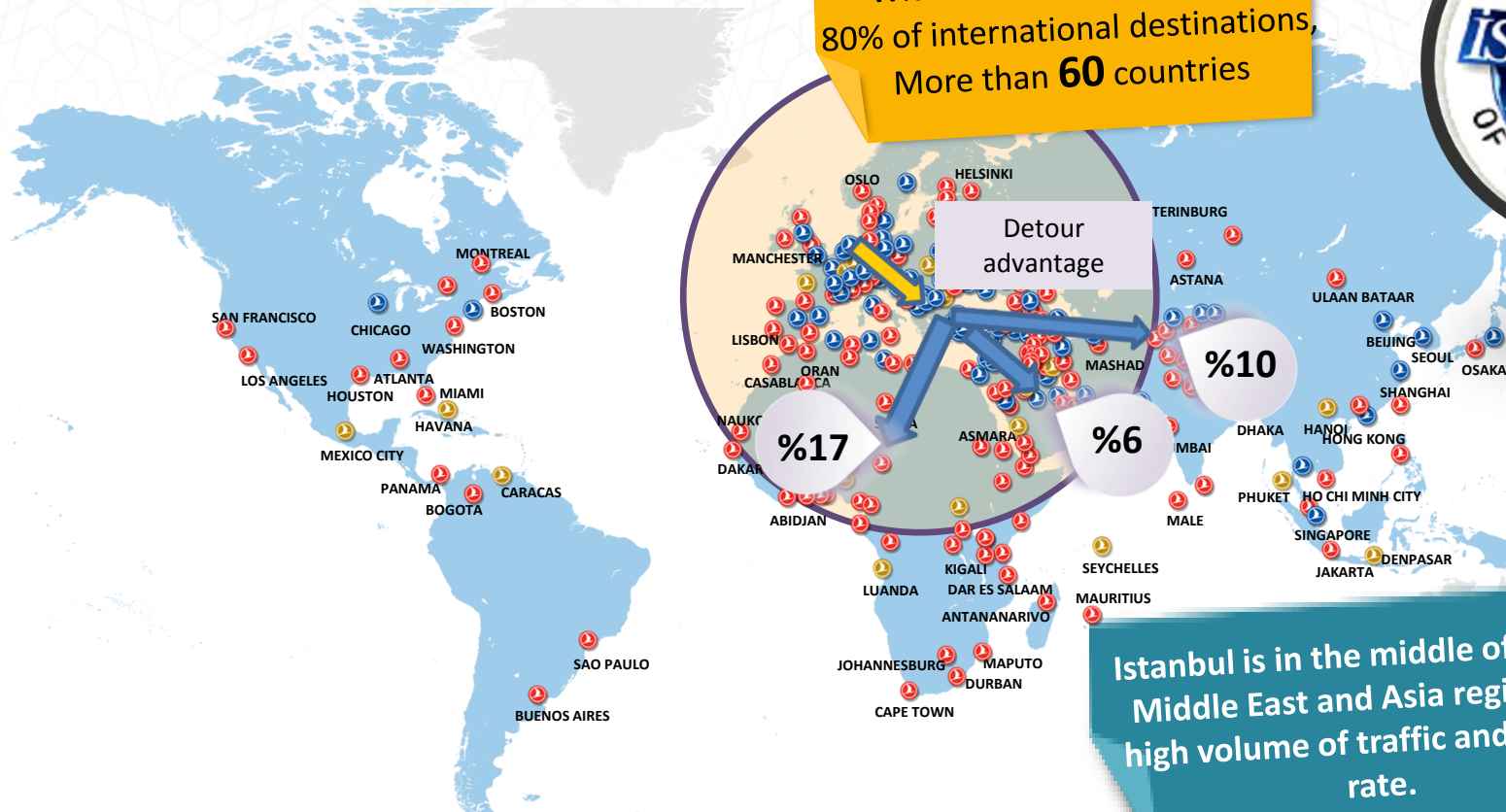


Cities With Highest Connectivity

rate.

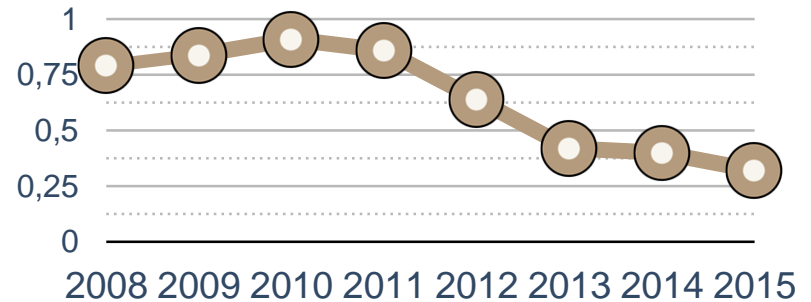

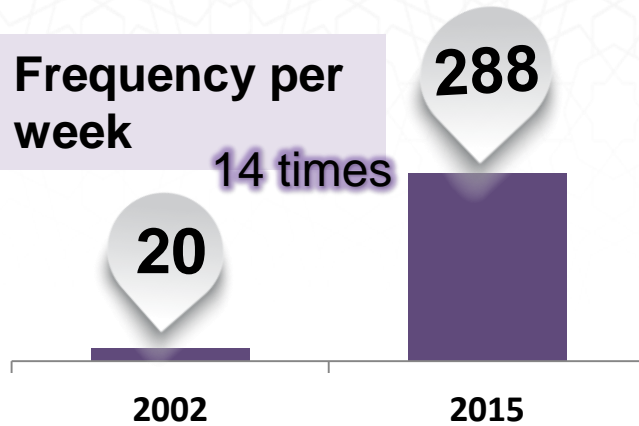

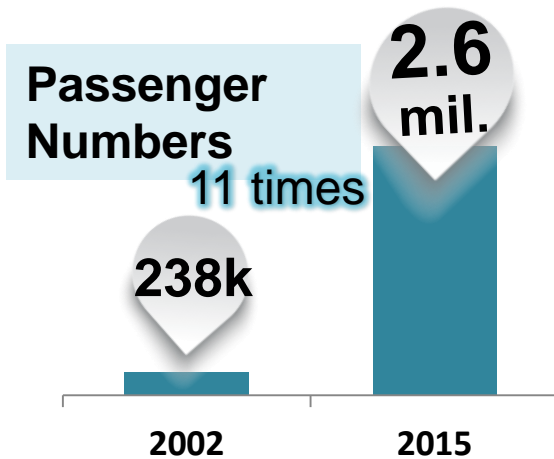


Turkish Airlines In Africa

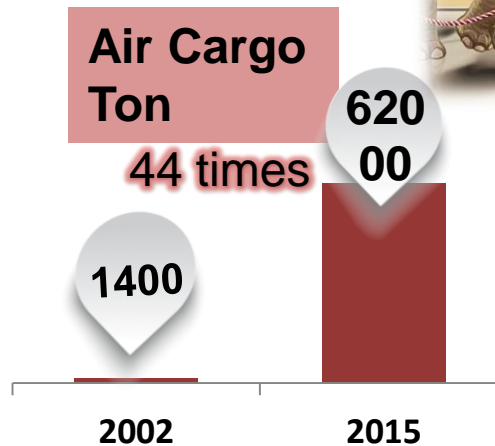
Frequency per week

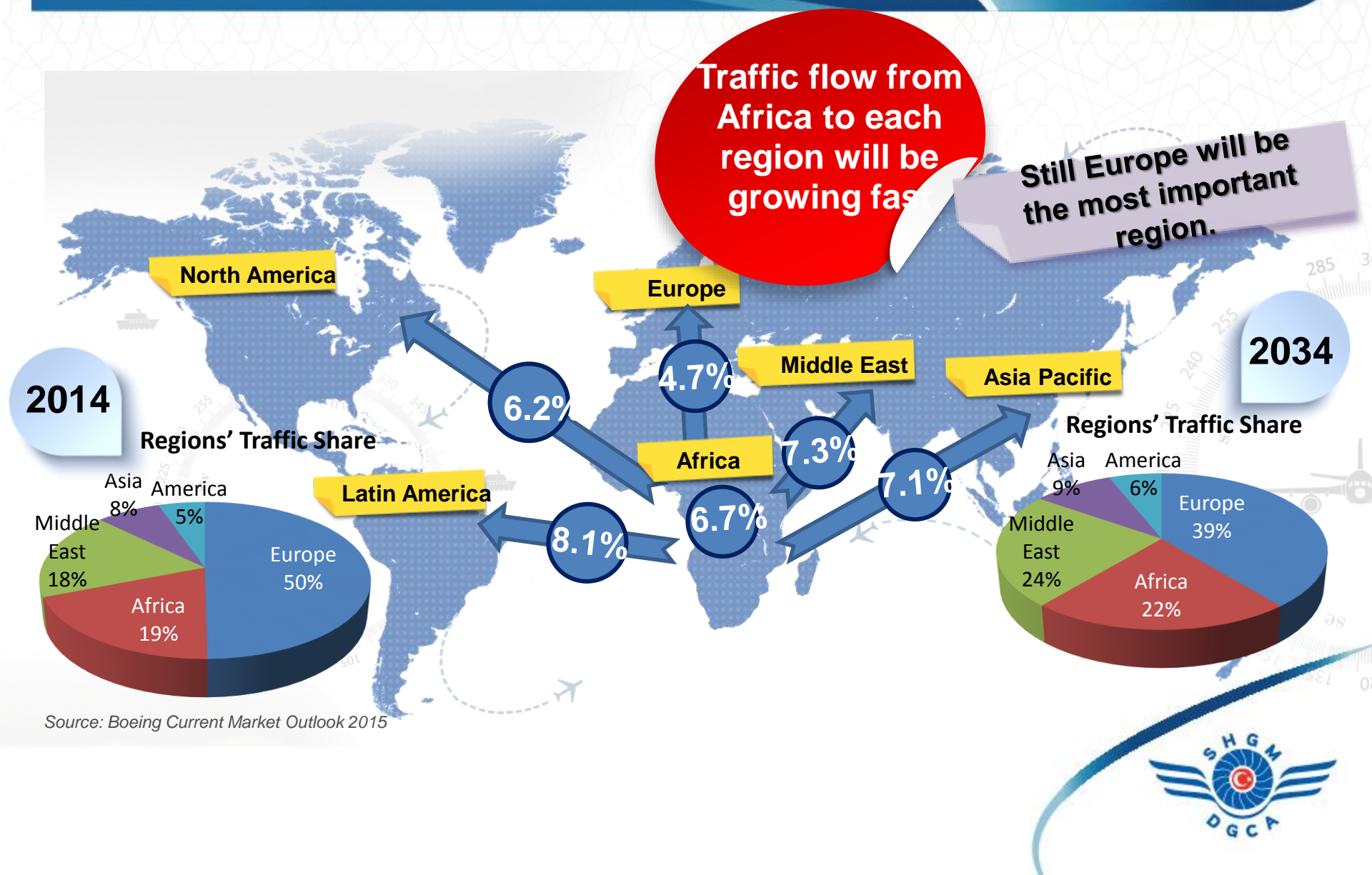

- ❑ On February 19th, 2015, Turkish government and ICAO signed a corporation MOU for the purpose of:

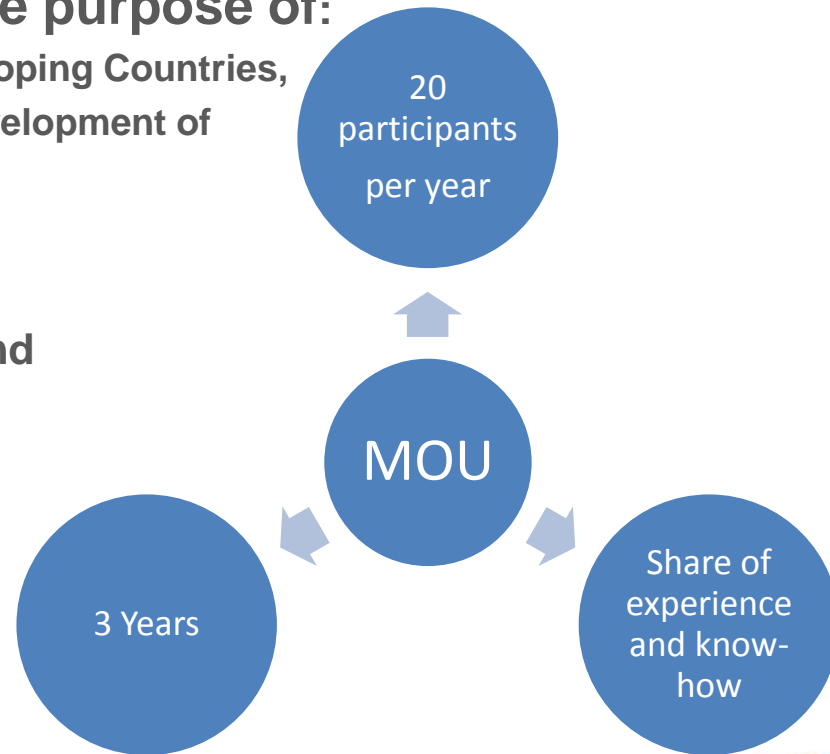
- Augmenting the capabilities of the Developing Countries,
- Promoting the safety and sustainable development of civil aviation.

- ❑ Financial Contribution:

- Human Resources Development Fund
- AFI
- Voluntary Basis

- ❑ The implementation of MOU includes:

- Training of 20 participants annually
- 3 years period
- Except transport all costs will be covered

Turkish Civil Aviation Academy

- ✓ **New opportunity in Europe**

- ❑ **Close cooperation with AFCAC Secretariat**
- ❑ **First Contact in Dakar (May 2014)**
 - Committed to provide training/workshop on AIS
- ❑ **In 2014, 2 AIS trainings took place**
 - DR Congo, 28-31 July, 40 Participants (CAA/ANSP)
 - Angola, 24-28 November, 35 Participants (ANSP AIS)
- ❑ **AIS/AIM Training in Nigeria**
 - NAMA, **Lagos**
 - **23 – 27 November 2015**
 - 5 days
 - 53 participants from NAMA & CAA

□ Agreement between EUROCONTROL and IATA

- EUROCONTROL committed to assist IATA in its endeavour for African States to improve their capability to provide AIS/AIM
- Provision of expert workshops to support African States and their ANSPs in improving their AIS, including transition from AIS to AIM Roadmap
- A series of three workshops per State / ANSP over a two-year period, facilitated by EUROCONTROL and IATA
- IATA, in coordination with EUROCONTROL, decides to prepare workshops based on identified discrepancies and airlines' information
- Coordinated with ICAO to obtain direct feedback
- Extension of Agreement with IATA

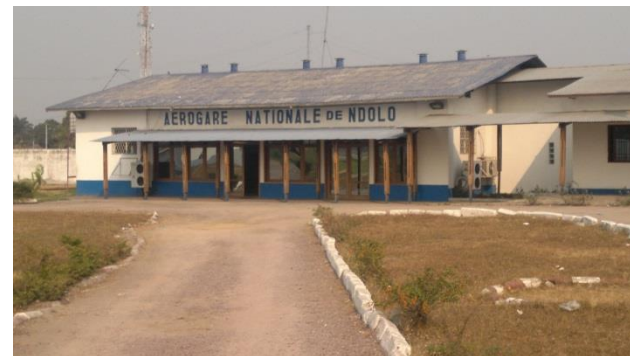
EUROCONTROL – IATA (*Next Steps*)

Implementation of AIS/AIM action plans in...

- **DR Congo**
 - AIS Office N'Dolo, Kinshasa
 - When: 26 – 30 September 2016
- **Angola**
 - ENANA, Luanda
 - When: October 2016
- **Nigeria**
 - NAMA, Lagos
 - When: November 2016

Duration: Minimum 5 days / State

Participants: Common session: 25 – 40 / State
OJT session: 2 – 5 / State
