- The African Aviation Training Roadmap was adopted by AFI SC Meeting in 2019 in Kampala, Uganda.
- The Roadmap was presented to the 40th ICAO General Assembly.



Challenges

- The COVID 19 pandemic has brought about enormous financial hardship.
- More than ever training will be under pressure to be as efficient as possible with scarce money.
- The industry is no longer thinking of expansion but wondering how it is going to survive.

Way Forward

- Seek technical and financial support from stakeholders and partners.
- Effectively engage ICAO GAT, AFI SC, AFCAC and states to implement the RM.

- AATO needs to pay special attention to safety and thus training to all professionals.
- Refresher training is inevitable to bring professionals to the required proficiency and likely some additional training to cope with the new normal.
