

EU-ASA project implementation highlights



EU-Africa Safety in Aviation (EU-ASA)

- All sub-Saharan Africa
- 5 M€ funded by the EU
- Started early 2019 and will end mid 2023

1. Reinforcement of ROs

- QMS Support for AAMAC, BAGASOO and CASSOA
- Web Conference with SASO


2. Regulation harmonisation at regional level

- Regulation harmonisation support for BAGAIA, BAGASOO, CASSOA
- Drafting of MoC between AAMAC, ASSA-AC and URSAC

3. Oversight support

- Country support missions AFCAC and URSAC
- Support AFI-CIS induction training – AFCAC
- Support Train the Instructor Course (TIC) for AAMAC and BAGASOO

PASTA-CO project implementation highlights



Central Africa

- ECCAS Member States
- 1.7 M€ funded by AfDB and the region
- Started in and will end mid 2022
- Since the beginning of the year: 75 persons trained



- AIR trainings (3)
- Other trainings (2)

3. Instructor training

- Train the Instructor Course (TIC)

Zambia project implementation highlights



Zambia

- 1.8 M€, EU funded
- Started mid 2017 and will last until August 2022

1. USOAP Support

- *Dedicated support in the areas of ORG, OPS, AIR, ANS, AIG, ATM, AGA*
- EI before 2016 30%, now 62,71% and 80% will be achieved in the next ICVM

2. Capacity building

- SSP implementation on-going > target level 4 achieved
- Support to improve regulations and processes in OPS, AIR, PEL, QMS, SSP

3. Organisation

- Involvement of industry
- New Component II on-going and coordination enhanced

Additional projects

Northern Africa - EuroMed

- 3 M€ project
- Currently in the inception phase

CORSIA Africa and the Caribbean

- 5 M€ project
- The inception phase is coming to a close

Support to SAATM

- 5 M€ project
- To be signed in the coming weeks




Conclusion
