## **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

### **1. GRAND OPENING OF THE AFI WEEK EVENTS**

1.1 The Grand opening was presided over by Mr. Mohamed Daghar, Principal Secretary (PS), State Department for Transport, Ministry of Roads and Transport. Others Dignitaries present were the President of the Council of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), Mr. Salvatore Sciacchitano; Mr. Juan Carlos Salazar, Secretary General of ICAO, Mr. Silas Udahemuka, President of the African Civil Aviation Commission (AFCAC), the African Union Commission (AUC) Commissioner for Infrastructure and Energy represented by Mr, Eric Ntagengerwa, Mr. David Pekoske, Administrator, United States of America - Transport Security Administration (TSA); Mr. Brown M. Ondego, Board Chairman of the Kenya Civil Aviation Authority ( KCAA) and Mr. Emile N. Arao, Director General of KCAA.

1.2 Highlighting Kenya's renown partnership with ICAO since it became party to the Convention on International Civil Aviation (Chicago Convention) on 1st May 1964 and subsequently a host State of the ICAO Regional Office for Eastern and Southern Africa (ESAF), the Permanent Secretary reassured the meeting of Kenya's continued commitment to partner and support ICAO.

1.3 Reenforcing the said commitment, the Permanent Secretary announced the Decision of the Government of Kenya to construct a dedicated Office facility for the ICAO ESAF Regional Office within the UN Complex in Nairobi between 2023 to 2026, and a policy commitment for a voluntary donation of USD 200,000 to ICAO for the AFI SECFAL Plan, as support to the implementation of enhanced aviation security and border control measures in Africa.

1.4 The President of the ICAO Council, in his remarks on the behalf of ICAO, expressed ICAO gratitude to the Government of the Republic of Kenya for accepting to host such a prestigious event and providing the excellent facilities to conduct the meetings in a very efficient and effective manner, in the city of Nairobi.

1.5 The President noted that the 2023 AFI Aviation Week events include the meeting of the AFI SECFAL Plan Steering Committee and AFI Plan Steering Committee respectively, membership of which include Partners. He expressed deep gratitude to the partners for their important updates and tremendous contribution, and support to the two AFI Plans.

1.6 He also recognized the valuable support that has been provided to ICAO by African States, through releasing of experts to provide the requested implementation support to beneficiary States. The President acknowledged several African States with high scores in the Universal Safety Oversight and Security Audit Programme, noting that the average Effective Implementation for ESAF and WACAF States under the USOAP has increased from 42% in 2014 to 57% by 2022 and under USAP has increased from 53% in 2015 to 64% by 2022.

1.7 He closed his remarks by expressing ICAO's sincere gratitude for the partnership and support of African States and aviation stakeholders.

1.8 Mr. Silas Udahemuka, President of the African Civil Aviation Commission (AFCAC) appreciated and thanked the government of Kenya, Kenya Civil Aviation Authority, and ICAO for hosting the AFI Aviation week. He also appreciated the stakeholders supporting the growth of aviation sector in Africa.

1.9 The TSA administrator thanked Kenya and ICAO for the kind invitation to attend the AFI week. He provided an overview of the long partnership between TSA and African States and the continuing cooperation they are enjoying with ICAO, that has supported the strengthening of aviation security measures globally.

1.10 The Board Chairperson of KCAA, expressed his pleasure and pride for ICAO selecting Kenya to host the Eighth AFI Aviation Week, that marked Kenya's continuity in supporting the aspirations of ICAO, as well as fulfilment of its obligations as a contracting State under the Chicago Convention. He noted that Kenya has a leadership role in the Region and on the Continent, hence the significance of hosting such an event translates positive outcome in shaping aviation in the region and beyond.

## **2. HISTORY OF THE MEETING**

2.1 The Eighth Edition of AFI Aviation week was held in Nairobi, Kenya from 21 to 25 August 2023. The events included the AFI Aviation Symposium, the 26th AFI Plan and the 12th AFI SECFAL Plan Steering Committee meetings.

2.2 The events were attended by more than 400 participants from African States, non-African States, International Organizations, RSOOs, RAIO, Industry, partners, and representatives of the AFI Group. The list of participants is provided in Attachment C to this Report.

2.3 The Overall Programme/Agenda is presented in **Appendix C**.

### **3. OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT**

3.1 The events objectives were as follows:

- a) Bring together the main actors in civil aviation to exchange and share experience on key topics related to capacity building, aviation safety, air navigation capacity and efficiency, aviation security and facilitation, air transport, economic development and environmental protection;
- b) Review activities of the AFI Plan, consider the report on the implementation status of the Plan 2022/2023 work programmes, approve the updated programmes/projects and provide guidance as required; and
- c) Review activities of the AFI SECFAL Plan, consider the report on the implementation of the Plan 2022/2023 work programmes, review the implementation status of the recommendations of the last meeting of the Regional Aviation Security and Facilitation Group (RASFALG-AFI), and provide guidance as required.

### **4. MEETING OUTCOMES**

4.1 The AFI Aviation Symposium was held on 21 and 22 of August 2023 in Nairobi, Kenya, as part of the 8th AFI Aviation week. The meeting was attended by more than 400 participants including delegations from member States, the ICAO Council, and the Air Navigation Commission (ANC) members, officials of invited Regional Organizations, industry and other partners and stakeholders. 4.2 The Twenty-Sixth Meeting of the Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Safety in Africa Steering Committee (AFI Plan SC/26) was held on 24 August 2023 in Nairobi, Kenya, as part of the 8th AFI Aviation week. The meeting was attended by more than 400 participants including delegations from member States, the ICAO Council, and the Air Navigation Commission (ANC) members, officials of invited regional organizations, industry and other partners and stakeholders. The outcomes of the Twenty-Sixth Meeting of the Steering Committee of the

4.3 The 12th meeting of the Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Security and Facilitation in Africa (AFI SECFAL Plan) Steering Committee (SC) was held in Nairobi, Kenya, on Kenya, on 23rd August 2023 as one of the Africa and Indian Ocean Region (AFI) Aviation Week Events hosted by the Republic of Kenya. The meeting was attended by more than 290 participants including delegations from member States, the ICAO Council, and the Air Navigation Commission (ANC) members, officials of invited regional organizations, industry and other partners and stakeholders. ## 5. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

5.1 During the 5th day of the AFI week under the agenda item of any other business two items naming the management of the HRDF and the governance structure of the AFI Plans were discussed and the following Decisions were made:

- The ICAO and AFCAC Secretariat to meet with the AFI group before the end of September 2023 to review the report of the Human Resource Development Fund (HRDF) Task force and management committee key recommendations and propose concrete implementation actions. AFCAC and ICAO secretariat to avail the necessary documentations; and
- The AFI Plan and AFI SECFAL Plan secretariat to facilitate extraordinary meetings of the respective Steering Committees to review the management structure including the Terms of reference of the Steering Committees.

## 6. CLOSING REMARKS

6.1 Ambassador Esono Anguesomo appreciated and thanked the government of Kenya for hosting the 8th AFI Aviation Week event successfully. He also thanked the secretary general of ICAO and his team for the continued work that they have been doing to support aviation in Africa. He finally called upon partners to continue their support and to closely work with ICAO and member States to

enhance effective implementations in Africa and he wished all delegates a very safe journey to their respective destinations.

6.2 The Director General of the Kenya CAA appreciated the very interesting and vibrant discussions during the AFI Aviation week and called upon the State delegates, the industry representatives, and all participants to work together for the benefit of the region and enhance the safety of our skies. He thanked all participants for coming to Nairobi and making the AFI Aviation Week a successful event, also extended his invitation for the upcoming events including the 2nd Global RSOO forum events in Kenya.

6.3 In his closing remarks, Mr. Juan Carlos Salazar, Secretary General of ICAO, thanked the Government of the Republic of Kenya for the incredible hospitality and unreserved effort in making the 8<sup>th</sup> African Aviation Week such a great success. He also recognized and thanked the Directors General of Civil Aviation Authorities, the Chairs of the AFI Plan and AFI SECFAL Plan Steering Committees, the States' representatives to ICAO, the ICAO Council and Air Navigation Commission Representatives, the delegates, the ICAO staff, and the many others involved in the 8th AFI Week's for their effective participation and results-driven collaboration.

6.4 He underscored the importance of gender equality and women's empowerment in the transformative agenda ICAO has embarked on through the implementation of the ICAO Gender Implementation Plan 2.0 and the ICAO People Strategy. He confirmed the commitment and dedication of the ICAO team to reducing the gender gap in aviation in Africa and throughout the world.

6.5 Finally, he emphasized the need to continue to work together to realize the vision of connecting Africa and the world, reaffirmed the full commitment of ICAO to support the development of civil aviation in Africa, and appreciated the Member States and regional and international organizations who are contributing so significantly to achieving this goal.

## **APPENDIX A - THE OUTCOMES OF AFI AVIATION SYMPOSIUM**

### **Session 1 - Capacity Building**

- ICAO/Organizations to continue supporting AFI States with trainings/workshops on priority areas including NGAP, on practical application of the ICAO Aviation Training and Capacity-Building Roadmap and ICAO policies on international air transport.
- ICAO/Organizations to support the AFI region capacity building in key critical areas through mobilizing resources under the no country left behind initiative.
- States are encouraged to include NGAP and Gender Equality in national aviation plans to include inter alia skills inventory and graduate databases.
- Training centres are encouraged to develop more courses and ensure availability of trainings supporting all the ICAO Strategic Objectives.
- The ICAO Secretariat and AFCAC Secretariat to meet with the AFI group by end of September 2023 to review the report of the Task force and the HRDF management committee key recommendations and propose concrete actions for implementation. The AFCAC and ICAO secretariat to avail the necessary documentation prior to the meeting.

### **Session 2 - Aviation Safety**

- High performing States are encouraged to share their experiences with other States in strengthening and maintaining of their Safety oversight systems. ICAO Regional Offices are requested to facilitate these experiences sharing through existing regional mechanisms.
- ICAO, Organizations and Partners are encouraged to develop effective focus projects that support low performance States toward the achievement of the GASP and GANP targets.
- States and Organizations are encouraged to join the ASAA initiative on the effective incident and accident data collection in Africa to improve the reporting and the quality of data and ensure the establishment of an enabling environment that promotes a just culture.

### **Session 3 - Air Navigation Capacity and Efficiency**

- States, Organizations, Airlines, Services Providers to reinforce their collaboration through the Collaborative Decision Making (CDM) by pooling the various initiatives toward the APIRG harmonized planning, implementation, operation, and monitoring framework.
- Services Providers, airlines, airports, and industry partners should consider their role in the digitalization of the systems and services and take advantage of systems and tools already developed to improve the efficiency of the air navigation.
- Air Navigation Service Providers are encouraged to reinforce their cooperation and promote the ANS Peer Review programme through the adhesion of new Peers.
- AUC to coordinate the establishment of a Task Force on the seamless sky for Africa to assist in developing policies and initiatives to support harmonized implementation of the industry initiatives related to the seamless sky.

### **Session 4 - Aviation Security and Facilitation**

- High performing States are encouraged to share their experiences with other States in strengthening and maintenance of their Security oversight system and implementation of Annex 9 – Facilitation SARPs. ICAO regional Offices are requested to facilitate this experience sharing through existing regional mechanisms such us the AFI-CES Cooperative Experts Scheme.
- States/Organizations are encouraged to support the ICAO Cyber security Action Plan developed in 2020 to ensure the resiliency of the civil aviation sector to cyber-attacks.
- The African Union Cyber Security Experts group created in 2018 provides guidance and strategies to African Union with the aim to adopt, monitor, prevent, mitigate, and address current and emerging cyber security threats and data misuse. The ratification of African (Malabo) Convention on cybersecurity and personal Data protection (2014) was emphasized.
- In 2016, the African Union Assembly, in Kigali Rwanda, adopted a decision that launched the African passport, and called upon the Commission to support member States to use it. States are therefore encouraged to ratify the Free Movement Protocol.

- To enjoy full security benefit verification of electronic passports, States are encouraged to join PKD. In addition, implementation of API and PNR remain low in Africa, thus impeding the fight against terrorism and transnational organized crime. States are therefore urged to expedite the implementation of API and PNR.
- ICAO to spearhead the development of comprehensive cybersecurity ASTP, which should be made available to the ASTCs for capacity building in respective AFI States.

## **Session 5 - Air Transport and Economic Development**

- States are encouraged to implement the Assembly Resolution A41-27 and ICAO policies and guidelines on charges, in particular the four key charging principles of non-discrimination, cost-relatedness, transparency, and consultation as set out in ICAO's policies in Doc 9082, in national legislation, regulation or policies.
- States, financial and technical, partners and stakeholders are encouraged to support the SAATM Pilot Implementation Project (PIP) Initiative, that seeks to stimulate traffic through additional 5th freedom routes align their air service agreements (ASAs) with the YD-compliant template and to harmonize/domesticate the YD regulatory texts.
- States and stakeholders are encouraged to solicit the political will of the leaders by promoting the benefits of fully implementing the YD/SAATM and to avoid protectionism.
- States and partners are encouraged to support and facilitate AFCAC activities towards a harmonized economic regulatory practice by African States under a Single Air Transport Market.
- AUC and AFCAC with the support of ICAO should establish a high-level decision-making forum to discuss and agree on user fees, charges and taxes on aviation, with the aim to find appropriate balance that can support the development of air transport in Africa. ICAO urged Member States to participate in the current panel discussions where Doc 9082 is currently being reviewed.
- AUC to convene a conference gathering all stakeholders (States, airlines, airports, Organizations, etc.) to discuss cost-effective and resilient initiatives and programmes aiming to make air services affordable.

## **Session 6- Environmental protection**

- States and relevant stakeholders are encouraged to join the ICAO Assistance, Capacity building and Training for SAF (ACT-SAF) Programme and take advantage of all the support initiatives provided under the umbrella of the ACT-SAF by ICAO, AFCAC and industry Partners. States are invited to take advantage of the opportunities created by this Programme to develop their full potential in SAF development and deployment.
- States are encouraged to attend the third International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Conference on Aviation and Alternative Fuels (CAAF/3) and submit documentation for discussion at CAAF/3 by 17 October 2023. States are also encouraged to ensure Minister-level participation in the high-level segment on 20 November 2023. In addition, ICAO, AFCAC and industry Partners were requested to ensure that information relating to SAF is provided under ACT SAF to promote better understanding and better preparation for the CAAF/3.
- States are urged to provide accurate feedback to the African States Index Survey for SAF/LCAF survey, participate in the High-level Dialogue of African States' Policy Makers on SAF (2-6 October 2023, Dakar, Senegal) as well as the Africa Climate Week (4-8 September 2023, Nairobi, Kenya).
- States are encouraged to monitor and report their progress toward the ICAO global environment aspirational goals through the development and update of their States Action Plans on CO<sub>2</sub> emissions reduction. African States are invited to support all the initiatives designed to enhance Environmental Protection on the continent through provision of regular feedback on identified States' needs that require specific interventions.
- ICAO is requested to consider creating environment learning solutions that are aligned to the UN Environmental Goals (Agenda 2050) and CORSIA.
