- Proposal to remove the “one over one under” rule i.e. allow two over 60 year olds to be at the controls
- Change 65 years co-pilot limit from Recommendation to a Standard

Subject: Pilot Mental Health - Expert Working Group Recommendations

The Aerospace Medical Association is a professional organization of 2,500 physicians, nurses and scientists engaged in the clinical practice of aerospace medicine and related research and education activities.

Recent events involving a potential disturbance of mental health in pilots (ref 1,2) prompted the

“recommend greater attention be given to mental health issues by aeromedical examiners and by the aviation community in general”

Remotely piloted aircraft systems



- ICAO Working Group
 - Proposal to use ICAO Class 3 (ATC) provisions as basis for medical requirements
 - No SARPs are proposed, only guidelines
 - State authorities make decision on medical fitness requirements

Cabin Crew Training Manual



- Under revision
- Mainly concerns non-medical aspects
- Medical chapter is included
 - Most input from industry WG (Dr Thibeault)
 - Proposals will be reviewed by a small group of CMOs from States – represent regulator's view
