Dear Sirs,

We refer to the ICAO State letter 2011/1 on the above mentioned subject, and apologize for our late reply.

Norway has fully implemented the language proficiency requirements with regard to pilots, air traffic controllers, AFIS- and HFIS-personnel.

The requirement has not yet been implemented for HF-personnel. We are also considering whether the language proficiency requirements should be implemented for HLO-personnel (helicopter landing officers), and for radio operators involved in offshore helicopter operations in Norway (indicated as "other" in the implementations plan). We hereby submit our implementation plan regarding these categories of personnel.
