It is expected that from 01/02/2013 to 28/02/2013 all remaining pilots and all Air Traffic Controllers will be tested by examiners from Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority. Meanwhile the DCA is planning to train testers who will be permanently engaged by DCA before mid next year (2013). Also the Zambia Air Services Training is expected to be approved as an ATO by mid 2013 and among its activities will be Aviation English Language training and testing.
