1. **INTRODUCTION**

1.1 The purpose of this paper is twofold: to establish a workplan for the different activities undertaken in the programme and to plan the second coordination meeting for the ICAO-endorsed GSI centres.

2. **DISCUSSION**

2.1 Scheduling of Follow-up assessments

For endorsed centres that have not yet had a follow-up assessment, participants are invited to plan and schedule this assessment during the delivery of a GSI courses and advise ICAO as soon as practicable.

2.2 Scheduling of GSI Courses

Participants are invited to advise ICAO of their plans to conduct courses during the next 18 months.

2.3 **Reporting of GSI Course Deliveries**

Participants are invited to provide information concerning delivered GSI courses by January 2006. For courses that will be delivered until January 2006, prior to the availability of the GSI secure web-based application, participants are invited to use the reporting template found in the Appendix to Discussion Paper No. 4.

2.4 Language Version of GSI Courses

Participants of endorsed centres using language versions of the GSI courses are invited to indicate their willingness to be language focal points for the GSI Programme.

2.5 **GSI Courses on Surveillance**

Participants of endorsed centres are invited to indicate their willingness to participate in the development of GSI courses on surveillance and advise on the type of assistance they could provide.

2.6 Finalization of GSI web-based application

ICAO will advise endorsed centres once the secure GSI web-based application has been finalized. Participants are invited to consult the GSI public website on a regular basis and to ensure that updated information concerning course schedule is provided to ICAO at their earliest convenience.

2.7 Scheduling of Second Coordination Meeting

A coordination meeting is to be conducted every three years. Therefore the next coordination meeting should be conducted in the Fourth Quarter of 2008. Participants are invited to indicate their willingness to participate in this activity.
