

# Jose Riveros Gutierrez



Mr. Jose Riveros joined the Civil Aviation Administration of Colombia in 1994 as a Project Manager and Supervisor for implementation of Nav aids in Colombia. He also worked on field in the installation and maintenance of nav aids and telecommunication equipment as well as ground assistance for flight testing. Since 2000, Mr. Riveros worked in research and implementation of communications, navigation, surveillance/air traffic management (CNS/ATM) systems and technologies.

From 2001 to 2006, Mr. Riveros worked at the San Buenaventura University in the creation and delivery of specialized courses on nav aids and transition plans for aeronautical postgraduate studies, as well as FANS and CNS/ATM Technologies for the aeronautical programme. Mr. Riveros established and coordinated the first postgraduate academic program for specialized studies in GNSS in Colombia.

Mr. Riveros worked 7 years for the International Civil Aviation Organization's (ICAO) Technical Cooperation Bureau as a Field Project Officer for the South American Countries and Panama, managing projects with a yearly program size of about US\$50.000.000. He has worked extensively in project management including project management techniques and software.

With the creation of ICAO's Global Aviation Training in 2014, Mr. Riveros was appointed Training Officer assessing training organizations and working with the TRAINAIR PLUS Programme in the implementation and delivery of ICAO training.
